Appendix 6: Genealogical Case Studies

These follow a similar format, starting with the man's birth year or estimate and birthplace, followed by the area of Suffolk their birthplace relates to (North East, South East, Mid-West or South West) and continuing through their lives with facts found from the Census returns (1851-1911), parish and statutory birth, marriage and death records and other records as relevant. Sources are cited in the footnotes.

The children's birth year estimate and place is taken from the Census record(s) following their birth referenced, unless otherwise cited in the footnotes.

The 'Arrival Burton' year is in some cases an estimate. The year or estimate has been used to inform the Results and Discussion (Table 5).

Lodgers or Boarders living with the families, recorded in the Census are shown in blue text. Boarders usually would have paid for meals as well as accommodation. Some people recorded in either category may have been relatives of the Head or his Wife.

Birth	James was born about 1840, in Cratfield or Halesworth (6 miles apart), in Suffolk, according to the 1881 and 1891 census returns respectively. A civil registration or baptism record was not found. Parents not established.

John's younger brother Robert COOPER, born about 1859 in Cavendish, also moved to Burton. He was recorded in 1881 in Burton upon Trent as a brewer's labourer and son, living with his mother Elizabeth, sister Eliza and lodger, John Walker from Cavendish in Burton upon Trent.⁹³ In 1891 he lived in Burton Extra as a brewer's labourer with his wife.⁹⁴

There were several other maltsters recorded in the Burton 19thC CEBs also called John COOPER:

- one slightly younger, born about 1859, Cavendish (Lodger, seasonal maltster - 1881)
- another younger, born about 1863, Sudbury (Lodger, seasonal maltster – 1891)
- one a little older, born 1852, Trimley, near Ipswich (Head, maltster - 1881; Head, brewer's labourer - 1891) who lived in Horninglow and should also be considered a Persister.
